2. OT-319. Proposed revisions to *University Senates Conference Organization and Functions*.

Consideration of adopting the *University Senates Conference Organization and Functions* document, which has been viewed by some as the Conference's governing document, as bylaws and changing the title as such. Additional revisions to the document would be considered at a later time.

3. ST-72. Revisions to the *Statutes*, Article X, Section 2 (Academic Freedom). Passed UIUC Senate 12/6/10. Passed UIC Senate 9/22/11. Passed UIS Senate 12/14/12. Transmitted to the President 1/18/13. Revised language approved by USC 3/18/14. Transmitted to Senates 3/21/14. Passed UIUC Senate 11/17/14.

The revised proposed language is being considered by the UIC and UIS senates.

4. ST-77/GR-46. Revisions to the *Statutes* and *General Rules* – Edits and Updates. *Statutes* transmitted to Senates 10/10/14. *General Rules* transmitted to the President 12/22/14.

The statutory changes have been transmitted to the senates. The Board of Trustees has requested a response by February 26. Additional revisions will be recommended, after the overall changes have been approved, that would define the presidential search committee.

The proposed revisions to the *General Rules* have been transmitted to the President. The section on Intellectual Property, Article III, will be transmitted to the senates along with the recommendation that this section be moved to the *Statutes*.

5. ST-79. Proposed revisions to the *Statutes*, Article II, Section 2.b, and Article XIII, Section 8 – to authorize the University Senates Conference to initiate revisions to the *Statutes*. Approved by USC 1/17/13. Transmitted to Senates 4/5/13. Revised language approved by USC 6/18/13. Transmitted to Senates 6/21/13. Passed UIC Senate 9/26/13. Revised language passed UIUC Senate 11/18/13. Transmitted to UIC and UIS Senates 11/26/13. Passed UIS Senate 2/21/14. Passed UIC Senate 4/24/14. Transmitted to the President 6/11/14.

President Easter has been asked to provide an update.

6. OT-316. University Senates Conference White Paper.

At its retreat, the Conference decided to develop a white paper to address various topics, including its role in shared governance and relationship with the Board of Trustees.
