- Chair Kar shares the idea that it might be helpful to develop a survey with some open-ended questions that are intended to help inform the senate executive committee about faculty experiences so that we can best represent the provost, the chancellor, and the president and that this document could be passed along to those administrators to help inform some of the decision makings and give a basis to kind of push for various things the USC notices to be recurrent.
- Kar also feels it would be worthwhile to have a discussion among the USC during the Feb 26th meeting regarding the topic of possible system role in promoting global initiatives.
- Kar also feels that it would be important to review the 10 topics presented to the BoT back last year to help determine if progress has been made on these 10 topics.
